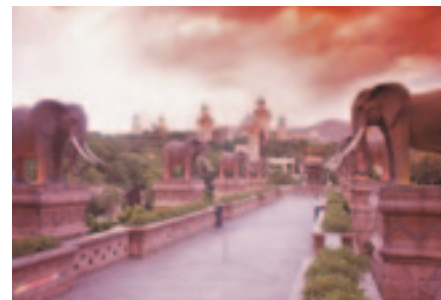
GARDEN ROUTE
