
Airport Logistics

Barcelona airport has two terminals: The main terminal is T1 where all regular flights arrive (British Airways, Lufthansa, KLM, Iberia, Air France, etc...). The second terminal is T2, where most of the low cost airlines arrive (Aer Lingus at Terminal T2-A and Easy jet, German Wings etc. at Terminal T2-B)

We can arrange for a hospitality desk to be located within the baggage claim, if required, otherwise our multi-lingual staff will wait for the guests in the arrivals hall of each of the terminals. Staff will meet and greet guests with signage bearing the company logo. Then they will escort them to the coaches which will be waiting at the parking bays just outside the terminals.

At Barcelona airport it is forbidden for coaches to park there for more than 15 minutes, therefore the coaches normally wait a few minutes drive away. Our airport staff will call the drivers once all the delegates have left the baggage claim, so they can move to the parking bays outside the terminals and then our staff will accompany the guests from the arrivals hall to the pickup point.

For transfers in smaller vehicles (cars or minivans) the drivers can come to meet guests at the arrivals hall and they can then walk together to the parking bays.

On arrival, our guests will be met at Barcelona airport and escorted to their vehicles for the first leg of their journey that will take them to a lovely seaside restaurant for lunch.

Location: By the beach in Gavá, a small seaside town, 30 minutes drive from Barcelona



Capacity: Up to 130 people in the restaurant and 150 on the terrace. There is also a BBQ and Lounge area

After lunch is over, the guests will be given their mission!

Tension is riding high between the English and the Spanish due to increased confrontation in Gibraltar. War is imminent and it appears that the Spanish are taking English tourists hostage!

In order to avoid being taken captive, the teams must find their way to their safe houses in the countryside where they will spend the night. On the way, they must find food and provisions without the authorities discovering them. An undercover group has hidden parcels for them in different locations. They must find these if they want to eat tonight.





It appears that some locals, owners of a handful of wineries, are secret accomplices of our hunted guests. A large part of their wine production is sold in the UK so they are willing to help save the guests from becoming hostages by hiding food parcels on thier estates. Can our guests find their food before they are busted by the local authorities.

Our guests must try to look as Spanish as possible to remain under the radar and, if they are nabbed, will have to prove that they have Spanish blood by carrying out a typically Spanish activity (such as making great sangria or playing the castanets). If they pass these tests they will get a Spanish stamp on their passports and be allowed to move on. If not, they may be detained for questioning and find themselves under greater scrutiny.

Fortunately, our guests have been provided with Spanish disguises in their vehicles so that they blend in to their new surroundings.



Once the guests have made it to their safe houses, they can settle in and relax before it is time to meet up with some of their compatriots for a clandestine dinner.

Their challenge tonight is to make an authentic paella. If they manage to do so, they will be given diplomatic immunity for the rest of their stay in Spain and be allowed to fly home at the end of their trip. However, they must continue to appear Spanish (they don't want to raise any suspicions) until they reach their final destination where they will meet their colleagues and celebrate their freedom.





After a good night's sleep and a hearty breakfast, our guests must make their way to their final meeting place without looking too conspicuous. The teams must follow their route to the hotel and also complete additional tasks to prove their Spanish lineage further.

These will include a cava tasting in which they have to identify a prosecco which has been sneaked in to trick them, a ham tasting in which they have to identify the best quality product, the creation of a Gaudi-style mosaic, and some flamenco moves.





The guests will complete these final activities to acquire their Spanish nationality and secure assured freedom.

To celebrate they will enjoy an afternoon of relaxation followed by dinner and party to round off their trip.
