- You will visit the posh Recoleta neighbourhood, named after the religious order which had its monastery there, the neighbourhood is associated principally with the Pilar Church and the magnificent Cemetery.
- There is, however, a great deal more to this area. Besides being the most elegant residential district in Buenos Aires, Recoleta is also an important nexus of culture, dining out and café-bar society. There are also scores of shops, from the predictable haute couture "maisons" on Avenida Alvear to hippie stalls and the latest in interior design.
- When the Prince of Wales visited in 1925, a special commemorative pamphlet described the area as "aristocratic, polished, artistic and magnificently beautiful".
- Even today, with hotels, towers, shopping centres and weekend rabble nudging their way between the old palaces and pathways, the neighbourhood retains a civic grandeur and European orderliness which is rare elsewhere in the city. People lucky enough to live near the cemetery enjoy access to a connecting patchwork of plazas and to the only public place aside from the major parks where cars do not pollute the land and air.





# TANGO

**IT TAKES TWO TO TANGO** is a saying used all over the world that shows just how widespread this dance has become. Tango is a huge part of the Argentine culture. It is a city dance, native to Buenos Aires, so where else should one go to learn and enjoy it? This improvised and passionate dance was born in the bordellos and immigrant neighbourhoods of Buenos Aires city in the late 1800s.



#### **Dinner and Tango Show**

Enjoy a first-class meal, be it the traditional steak, chicken or Patagonian lamb with a mouth-watering array of salads as well as any of a number of excellent pasta dishes before settling down for a tango show which includes some of the best-loved songs, music and dances performed by skilled musicians and dancers.

#### The Venue

A cabaret designed by Philippe Starck with an aesthetic created to evoke nostalgia, combined with the strength of a show full of fantasy and sensuality. History of tango is presented from the roaring 20s to Astor Piazzola, with unique, glamorous period costumes, and accompanied by a live orchestra and singers.

In most of the venues, one can combine dinner and the tango show, or just attend the show.

### **BUENOS AIRES** Day 3 – Saturday, 12<sup>th</sup> December 2020



Back in 1830 La Bamba lay on the "Camino Real" (Royal Road) that connected Buenos Aires to Northern Argentina. This is one of the oldest Argentine *estancias* (ranches). Its main building with a guard tower, stables and 200-year-old park are part of the history and birthplace of the Gaucho or argentine cowboy.

The Estancia's name comes from the Celtic word "Bahamba" which means "place of rest and hospitality". La Bamba was a pioneer in opening its doors to welcome guests. It has been receiving visitors from around the globe since the 1980s and underwent a complete update and renovation of its facilities. Today La Bamba keeps its original charm and shines in all its original grandeur.

La Bamba de Areco is a 1,5 hour drive out of downtown Buenos Aires, on the outskirts (13 km away) of the historical town of San Antonio de Areco, the birthplace of the gaucho. This Estancia is not easily accessed in wet weather (dirt road), because although they can send a car to pick up individual guests, this is not possible if it is a large number of people (busload).

## BARILOCHE LAKE DISTRICT Day 5 – Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> December 2020 Eclipse Day

### Eclipse Day Piedra Del Aguila, Patagonia



After an early breakfast at the hotel, we leave from the Andes area to the Patagonian steppe "estepa" in a private vehicle with an English-Speaking guide who is not only well versed in astronomy but also will talk about the region's wilderness and history.

- After 3 hours of ground transportation we will arrive eclipse location, where the team of experts will be waiting with their equipment so that everyone can enjoy the eclipse in a fascinating and safe way. All the experience is in private, but in a shared ranch (estancia).
- 11:45am the moon will begin to eclipse the sun. At 1:07pm the full eclipse (crown effect) will take place. After that the sun will start showing until 2:35pm where the sun eclipse is over.
- During the eclipse, telescopes and other equipment will be available to see the progress, we will also provide special eclipse glasses and yoga mats.
- Lunch will be available any time between 12 to 2pm. It includes fruits, typical finger food, sandwiches, beverages.
- 3:00pm transfer will be ready to go back to the hotel, arriving approximately at 7:30pm.






### **BARILOCHE LAKE DISTRICT** Day 6 – Tuesday, 15<sup>th</sup> December 2020




Sailing through the crystalline waters of Nahuel Huapi we arrive at the island. Centennial cypresses and coihues forests mixed with native and exotic wildlife will house every minute. There, we walk through the forests through inland trails, to observe its varied flora and fauna and learn about its history. The internal circuits of the Island will lead us to experimental beaches and exclusive coasts for the visitor several unique examples of trees such as the Arrayanes antique dealers.
