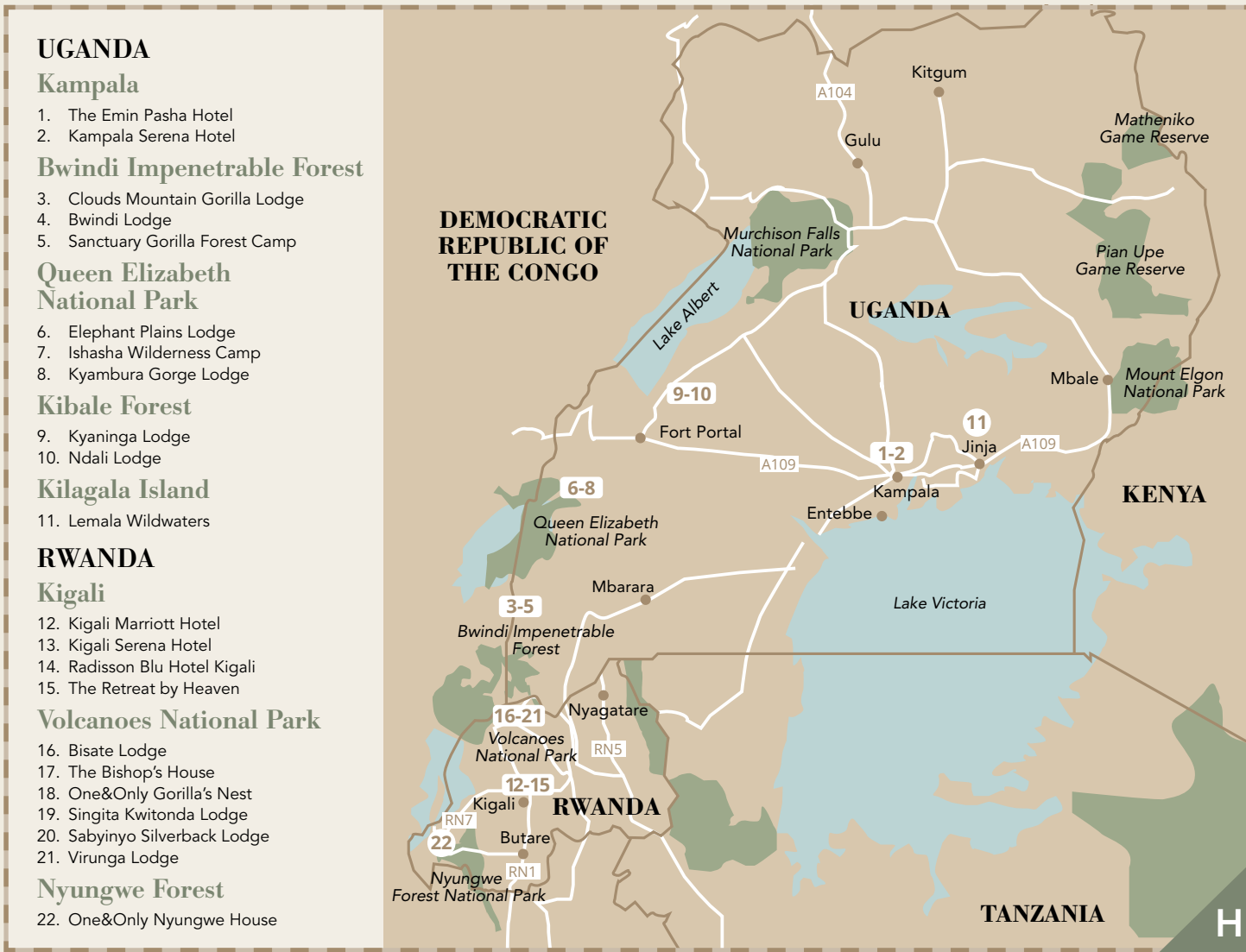
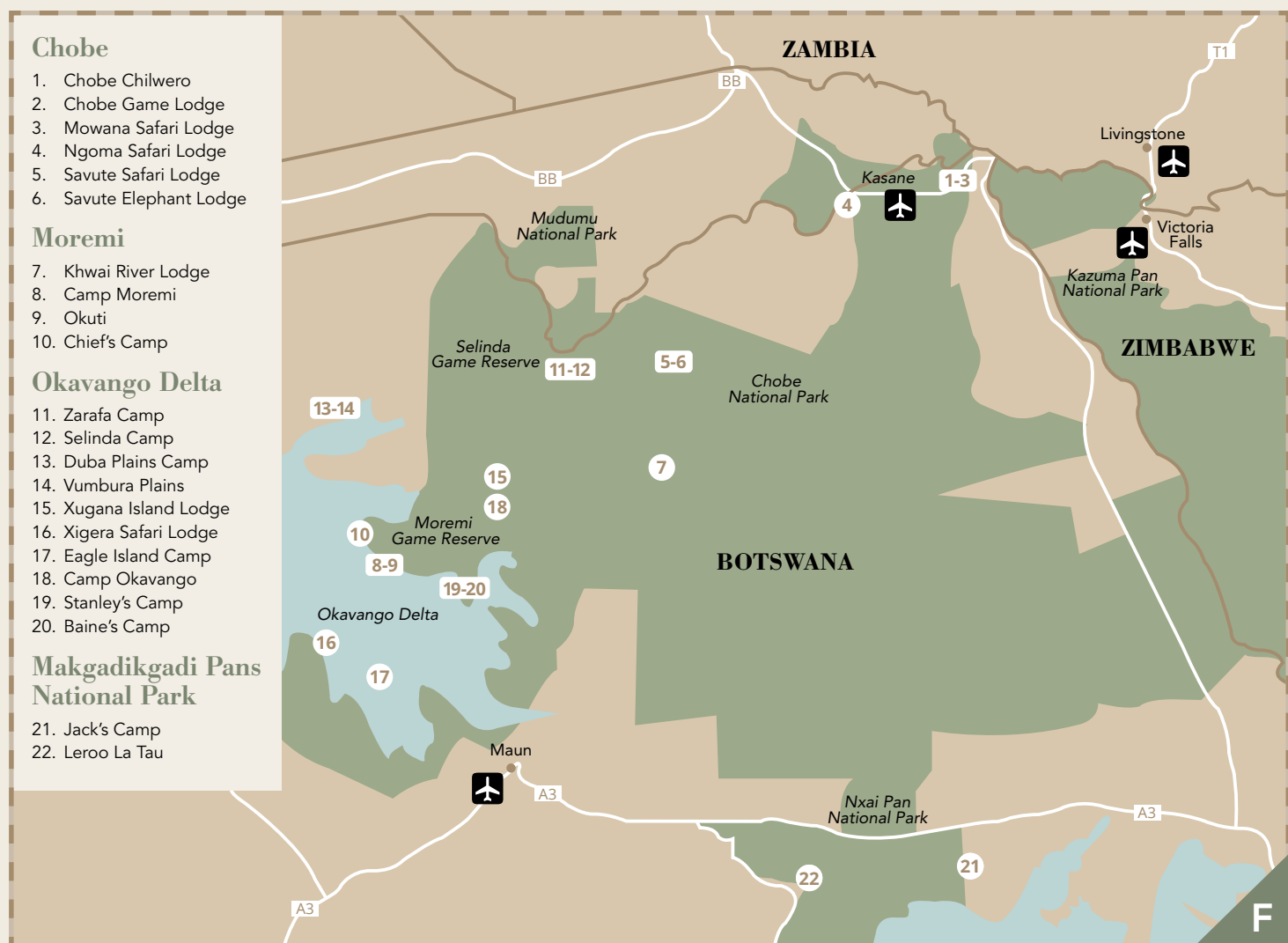
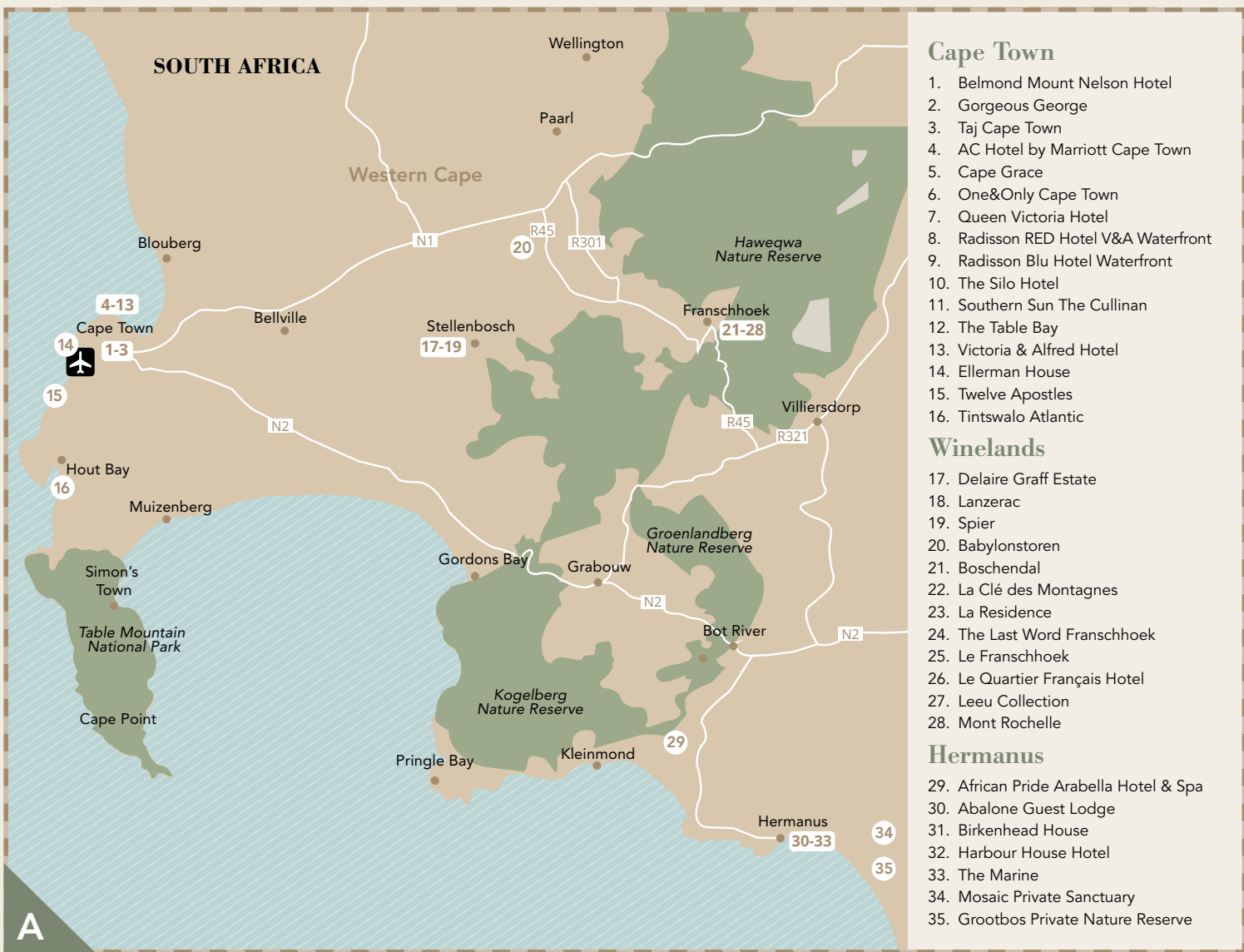

- Wildlife viewing in Amboseli National Park against a backdrop Tanzania's Mt Kilimanjaro



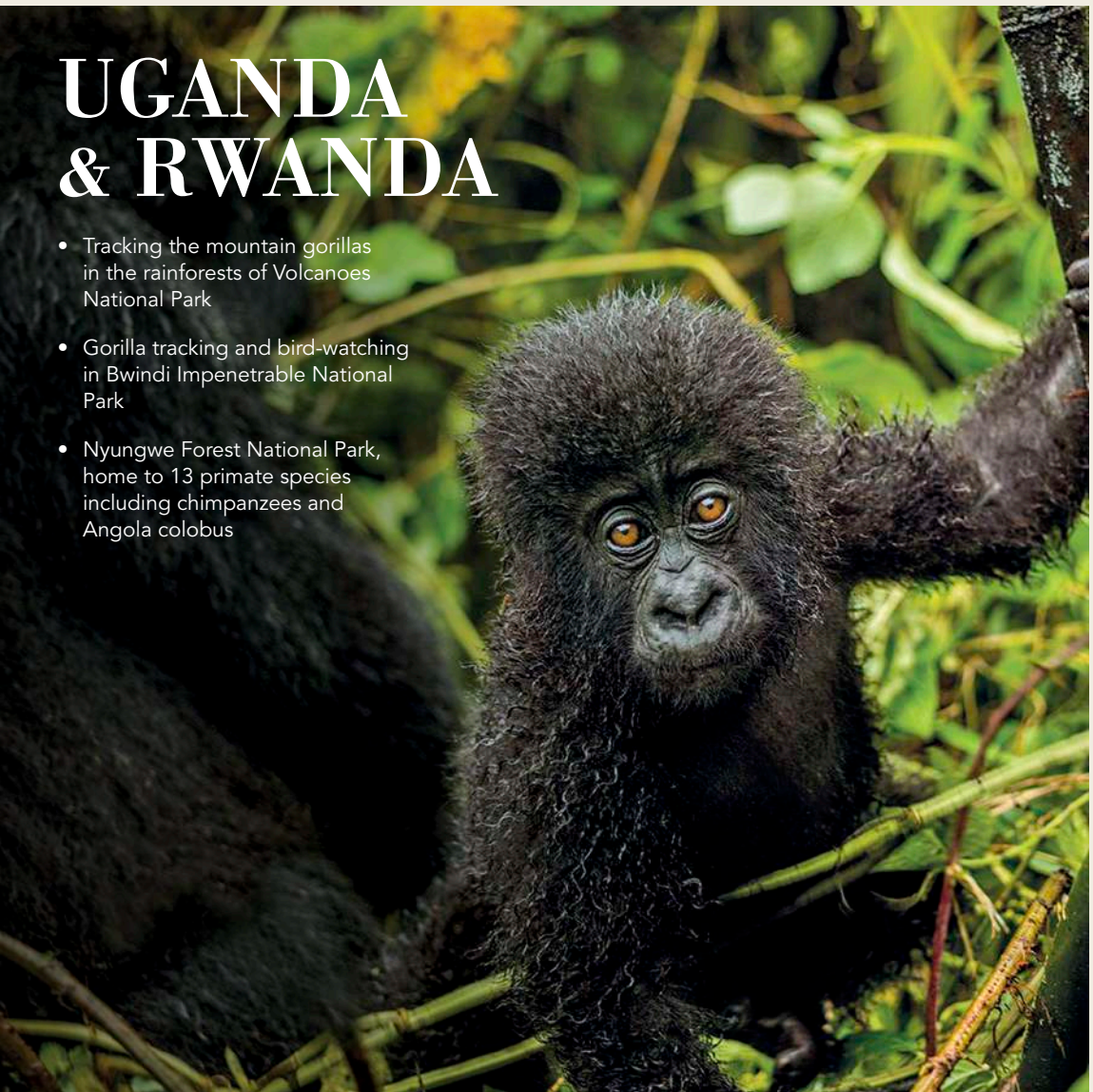
# TANZANIA
