Macuco Safari tour offers you a different way to admire the famous waterfalls in the Iguassu River. The tour begins with a ride in electrical vehicles, with open wagons, providing you a panoramic view as you go through the rainforest trail. After the ride there is a short walk in wooden paths, in case you have any difficulty walking, you will have the option to stay in the jeep. The third part of the tour will take you to the river, where there will be a bi-motor boat ready to take you upstream where you can almost touch the falls. The pilot will maneuver the boat to give passengers a refreshing shower in the fall.

Daily operation hours: From 9:15am to 4:00pm.

Transportation leaving the Hotel every full hour.

Duration: 2 hours approximately.

Children under 7 years old are complementary. Please note that the Hotel does not recommend this tour for kids under 4 years old.

Tours booked through the Hotel includes:

Built on the Paraná River between Brazil and Paraguay, forming a neutral zone between the two countries, Itaipu is the largest hydroelectric in the world in power generation. This big construction has impressive numbers as: The concrete used to build the dam is equivalent to 210 Maracanã Stadium and the iron and steel is equivalent to 380 Eiffel Towers, the spillway capacity is something like 40 times more than the normal flow of the Iguazu Falls. For that and other reasons, Itaipu was elected by the American Society of Civil Engineers as one of the seven modern Wonders of the World.

Itaipu can offer a range of attractions, providing an unforgettable visit, as you know closer the junction of art and technology, in addition to environmental actions taken in area.

A special tour allows the visitors to know the inside of the dam and visit the central control room, which controls the operation of the turbines and generators.

Note that the Special Circuit is performed in an industrial area and for the safety of visitors, only people over the age of 14 are allowed. It is also mandatory to wear long pants and closed shoes.



Why not to enjoy a half-day tour at the Argentinean side of the Iguazu Falls? Once there you will experience a different perspective of the beauty of the Fall, as well as being closer to the Devil's Throat. There is a choice of three circuits. The main circuit will lead you very close to the top of the highest waterfall, the Devil's Throat.

It is mandatory possession of Passport (for foreigners) or ID cards (Mercosul visitors. Please note that the valid document needs to have a photograph) for this tour.

For Americans, Canadians and Australians it is also mandatory the reciprocity document to cross the border, for guests on leisure or on business, which can be acquired online. More information and the forms can be found on the website: www.provinciapagos.com.ar/dnm/

Duration: 6 hours approximately, depending on the circuit and the immigration procedures.

The entrance can only be bought at the Park entrance and need to be paid in Argentinean currency. Your driver will assist you on the way to the Park to exchange the money.

We recommend you to wear comfortable shoes and clothes as you will be exercising. Rubber sole shoes are recommended as the pathways are wet and slippery.

Repellent and suns cream are necessary



The most spectacular way to see the magic of Iguassu Falls, it is with a 10 minutes helicopter tour. You will fly over the giant Iguazu National Park and circle the falls several times, allowing you to appreciate the nature and take great pictures. It is a breathtaking experience that will remain in your memories for a lifetime.

35 minutes flights are also available, not just flying over the falls, but also the Three Borders Landmark, the Itaipu Dam, the largest hydroelectric power plant in the world, the National Park and the city of Iguacu.

The tour depends on the weather conditions.

Please note that there is a minimum of 3 people to do the 10 minutes flight. Guest can share the aircraft with other people queuing at the Helicopter Pad or pay for the remaining seats in the aircraft.

Also note that the helicopter company does not accept reservations in advance. They work with first to arrive first to be served system. The exception is for the 35 minutes flight that can be booked in advance and guests will take the helicopter from the hangar.



For those looking for a real eco adventure this tour offers a genuine rainforest experience, both on land and water. The Black Well tour begins with a nine-kilometer trail that can be done by foot, by jeep or by bicycle. As you go through the rainforest, the guide will point out the highlights of the fascinating flora and fauna surrounding you.

Arriving at the river you can go up into an Observatory Tower, where you can observe the 'Lake of Caimans', a shallow muddy lake teeming with birdlife. The tour continues by motor boat and in the last 02 kilometers it is possible to row an inflatable kayak.

Duration: 4 hours approximately.

Departure time: 09:15am and 1:45pm.

The Bird Park is the most important breeding center for birds in South America. You will be fully integrated into the natural environment on this visit, and get really close to the birds, as the pathways passes through their nests.

During the visit, it is possible to marvel over 900 rare and colorful birds, divided into 150 different species, most of them are native from the surrounding forest. The Bird Park is an attraction that wakes our feelings about environmental problems.

Duration: 1 hour and 30 minutes approximately.

Opening Hours: from 8:30am to 5:00pm.

Please note that inside of the Birds Park, the pathways length has 2km. The pathways are flat and there are resting areas along the way.
