Meeting & Event Venue Developments

The Graduate Center, City University of New York, located in a historic building on Fifth Avenue at 34th Street, now offers a suite of spaces for private events, including a 389-seat auditorium, a 180-seat theater and more.

Convene, which has 14 locations in Manhattan, recently opened a multilevel downtown location at **One Liberty Plaza** with more than 90,000 square feet of event space and previously debuted a new space at **75 Rockefeller Plaza** with 9,000 square feet of mixed-use space available for meetings and events. The company's all-in-one pricing model covers catering, production costs, technology and venue design.

There's also the **Down Town Association**, an architectural gem located just a few blocks from Wall Street that features 10 unique spaces for private events, including the 1,665-square-foot Main Bar, an Edwardian-style club room where an oil portrait of George Washington greets attendees.

Convention, Exhibition & Meeting Space

Javits Center is the City's primary venue for large conventions, trade shows and special events. In January 2016, a \$1 billion redevelopment project was announced for the Javits Center. The project will include expansion by 1.2 million square feet for a total of 3.3 million square feet of exhibition and related space. This will result in five times more meeting and ballroom space and will also create the largest ballroom in the Northeast at 55,000 square feet.

Home of the Tribeca Film Festival and New York Fashion Week, **Spring Studios** brings together state-of-the-art equipment, modern aesthetics and a great location in the heart of Tribeca. Spring contains several studio spaces and can accommodate as many as 800 guests. A private rooftop terrace offers stunning views of Lower Manhattan.

NY5000 is a mega-block of 5,000 guest rooms, 100 meeting rooms and 225,000 square feet of meeting space, steps away from Times Square. This central convention package with New York Hilton Midtown and Sheraton New York Times Square Hotel provides group booking across both properties for all your accommodation, event and F&B requirements.

The Bronx Zoo makes for an incredible group experience. Your attendees can explore the sprawling park on their own or take part in activities like the Bronx Zoo Treetop Adventure, a separate attraction that features a two-way zip line that runs over the Bronx River and seven obstacle courses.

If you're looking to let attendees blow off some steam, Break Bar NYC on Manhattan's west side near the Javits Center has a back room where groups of up to 125 can break, smash or otherwise destroy a variety of items. There's also Escape Virtuality in Chelsea, which features both escape rooms and virtual reality simulation. Your attendees can play interactive games against each other or work together to craft an escape from one of several scenarios
