




Here **we** have been trusting with the KD / Premicon AG / Line for a total of 5 years, and then worked with TUI group and **organized their land excursions for the river cruise ships** TUI Allegra, TUI Sonata and TUI Queen **on the Rhine, Main and Moselle.**

Unfortunately, the TUI has discontinued its river cruise program at the end of 2014 so that we currently do not have an active partner in this area.

Through the purchase, management and support of all the services we have, however, good and close relations with many tourism associations, congress and marketing departments of the towns along the rivers. Through these institutions, we mainly book the tour guides for the excursions and have now sourced a large base of guides who we know are well received by the guests.

As a part of the seasonal care of the ships, it is above all flexibility and very good accessibility, as guest numbers and the status of land excursions are always reported only at very short notice. Also on the uncertainties in the nautics – (for example high and low water, delays caused by locks) - can only be operated at very short notice. Here we are tested and experienced, and not least because of this, the TUI group had been very happy to cooperate with us.

We also have good contacts to several cruise companies and can offer fullor part charter of river cruise ships at no higher rates than what you can find in the internet. Chartering a river cruise ship and designing individual shore excursions make a great incentive trip!







Mainz – Great Wine Capital

- Within that network: **Mainz is a way of life!** The capital of the German Federal State of Rheinland-Pfalz is situated on the banks of the Rhine River. **The German Wine Capital is famous for Johannes Gutenberg and his invention of printing with moveable types** and renowned for its carnival celebrations.
- **Rheinhessen** is Germany's largest wine-growing region, confined in the north and east by the great bend in the Rhine River. It is home to a number of sights that bear witness to its rich historical traditions. The cathedrals in Mainz and Worms stand out in the cities' skylines, as does the magnificent Katharinenkirche in Oppenheim.
- Most of all it is the Riesling wines that have been causing such a stir of late. Also, Rheinhessen's classic Silvaner grape has once again become a topic of discussion. Along with Riesling and Silvaner, the white Pinot varieties are also gaining favour. Red wine grapes have doubled in acreage over the past ten years. Dornfelder is the most important red variety, but classics such as Pinot Noir and Portugieser have also become more common in recent years.

Loess, limestone and loam are the main soil types. Rotliegendes is a red, slatey-sandy clay soil in the steep riverfront vineyards, and near Bingen there is an outcropping of quartzite-slate.

Organic viticulture has a long tradition in Rheinhessen. Thanks to people being increasingly aware of this concept, the number of winegrowers practicing organic viticulture here is on the rise!
