A Residential Meeting Combined with Teambuilding Activities (based on a 3 day stay)

Day One

- Half day meeting on arrival in The Sheridan, followed by a 2 course working lunch in The Montagu Room
- Afternoon spent by Pulteney Weir to partake in paddle boarding and a team challenge to build a bridge over the River Avon
- Free time to enjoy The Spa & Bath House and our fitness room facilities
- Cocktail flight demonstration prior to a 3 course dinner in one of our beautiful function rooms

Day Two

- Half day meeting in The Sheridan Room
- Lunch at The Marlborough Tavern, a traditional British pub, located at the end of the Royal Crescent


