



The Beauty of Tuscany & the Renaissance Wonders of Florence

DAY 1

Meet & Greet Rome/Florence airport. Private transfer.

(Program depends on arrival time)

Visit picturesque medieval towns of Orvieto, perched high on a cliff above a volcanic plain with a superbly preserved 13th century cathedral, Civita di Banorreggio accessed only way by way of a long foot bridge through an Etruscan city gate, and San Gimignano, the 'city of towers,' each one surrounded by breathtaking panoramic views.

Continue on to a 5* luxury hotel, Fonteverde the renaissance palace built for Grand Duke Ferdinando I de' Medici, or Belmond Castello di Casole a 39-room ancient villa that dates back to the 10th century.

Dine at the fine hotel restaurant.



DAY 2

Action packed morning

Explore the rolling hills of Chianti off-road on an ATV (Quad 4x4) with the wind in your hair.

Savour the renowned Bistecca alla Fiorentina prepared by master Signore Cecchini Dario in his family officina, accompanied by flowing local wine and great atmosphere.

VIP pick up, drive through the Chianti hills for an afternoon at leisure in the enchanting city of Siena, a true medieval masterpiece with its spectacular Piazza Del Campo.

Dinner in the historic city centre and return to hotel





DAY 3

Florence, the birthplace of the Renaissance and some of the greatest minds of all time

A full day to visit all the main attractions (and to shop): Piazzale Michelangelo for a stunning city panorama, Basilica Santa Croce, the final resting place of such illustrious figures as Rossini, Machiavelli, and Galileo Galilei, and the Academia delle Arti e dei Mestieri - home of Michelangelo's magnificent masterpiece, David.

Lunch at one of the best family-owned trattorias in the heart of the Mercato Centrale, the gastronomic market full of all the finest local produce: herbs, cheese, meats and more. The unwritten menu says, 'We have what we have and it's all amazing - eat and enjoy!'

An easy afternoon wandering the magnificent Duomo Santa Maria del Fiore, the 3rd largest church in the world, Piazza Signoria, Ponte Vecchio, Museo del Opera, the Medici Chapel, and the old San Lorenzo market place.

Evening fine dine on the river Arno and then stroll the streets to feel the magic of Renaissance Florence where it all began.

Return to hotel.

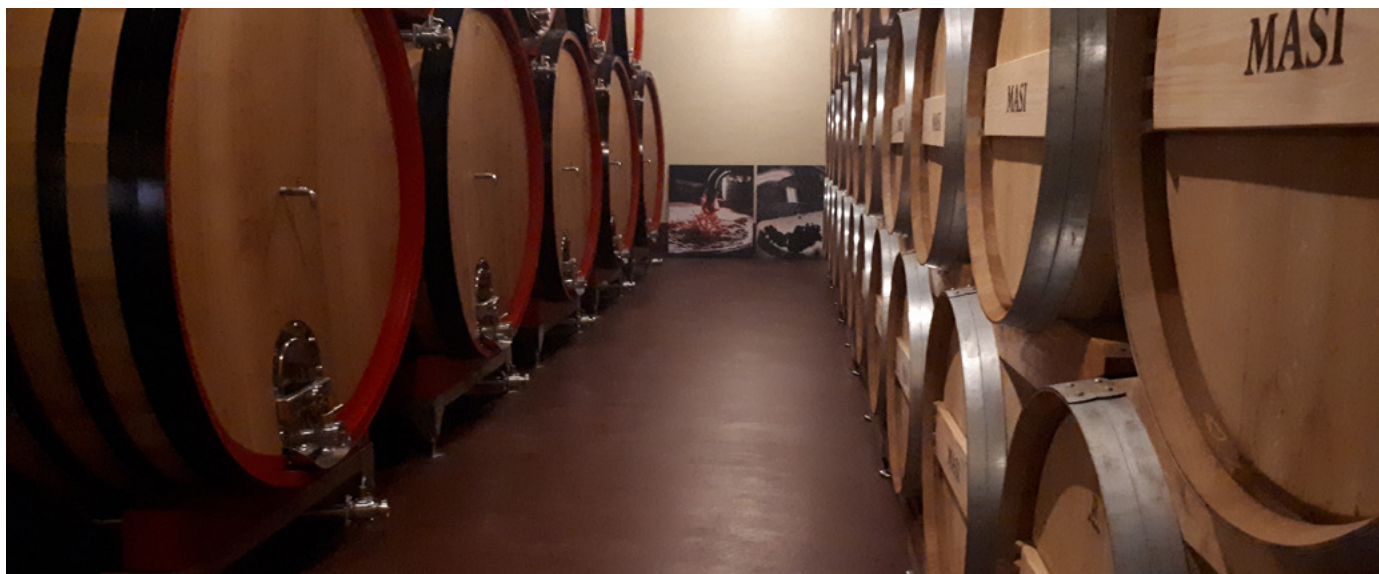
DAY 4
