- In 2021, Edmonton became the first city in Western Canada to be graded on its environmental efforts through the Global Destination Sustainability (GDS) Index, which ranks global destinations based on their sustainability performance in the tourism and events industry.
- From October 31 to November 12, 2021, Canada
 participated in the 26th United Nations Climate Change
 Conference of the Parties (COP26) in Glasgow, Scotland.
 Here, the government of Canada announced a more
 ambitious emission reductions target and a doubling
 of its climate finance commitment to help developing
 countries fight climate change and biodiversity loss.

EDMONTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Environmental excellence and responsibility are at the forefront of the Edmonton International Airport's (EIA) operations.

- In 2020, EIA announced the development of the world's largest on-airport solar farm – 627-acre, 120 MW facility. Construction is expected to begin by the end of 2022.
- EIA was the first airport in the world to sign **The Climate Pledge** committing to being carbon neutral by 2040.
- To continue its commitment to environmental sustainability, EIA has powered up a new natural gas **cogeneration facility** that will reduce the airport's annual carbon emissions by approximately 20% of CO2 equivalent per year, from the 2014 baseline.
- The EIA-Air Canada Sustainability Partnership was developed in 2021, to reduce the carbon impact of air travel. Both organizations are working together to test emerging green technologies at EIA's Airport City Sustainability Campus, an ecosystem that EIA created to foster environmental innovation.

In 2018, Edmonton hosted the first ever Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change's (IPCC) Cities and Climate Change Science Conference. Here, The Edmonton Declaration was developed at the Change for Climate Global Mayors Summit that took place during the conference. The declaration calls upon cities to take bold action on climate change. To date, 3000+ cities have endorsed the declaration.

Edmonton is a leader in electric public transportation. The Edmonton Transit Service (ETS) purchase of 40 electric buses is the largest, single purchase of electric buses in Canadian history.
