- High quality road infrastructure

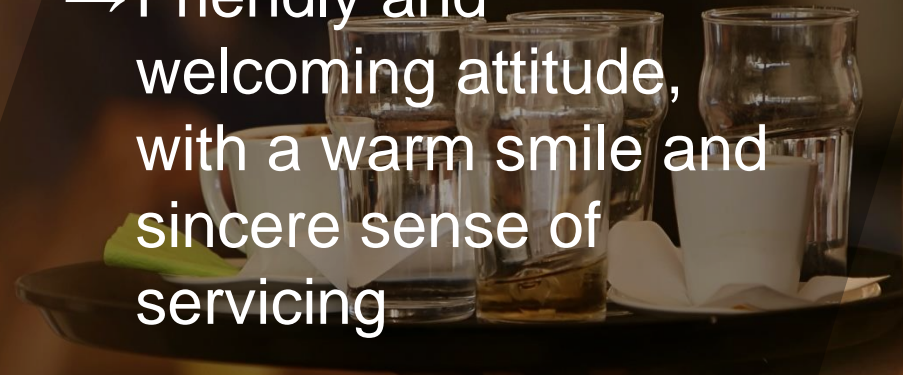


